AIN'T NO MOUNTAIN HIGH ENOUGH



On 24th June Luke Moscrop, VP Commercial Finance, will 'Everest' Ditchling Beacon, to raise money for INTO Giving. 'Everesting' is riding up as many times as necessary to climb 8,848 meters of elevation. Ditchling Beacon is 1.46km & has 139m of elevation in one climb. So, he needs to do it 65 times in a row! You could say this makes him a Cyclepath...

When asked about the challenge, Luke said, 'I've always pushed myself to try difficult things...ran the Brighton Marathon, cycled the North Coast 500 (miles) in 6 days, done various triathlons and cycle races, and helped to set a Guinness World Record running from John O'Groats to Lands End as a relay team in 2015.' The training is brutal, but he told us his dad's words keep him going: 'The race is not won by the strong or the swift, but by those who persevere against all else, until the very end'
